Marmet area library service options:

- **KCPL Bookmobile** will make regular stops each Thursday from 10 am to 1:00 pm and from 2:30 pm to 4:00 pm beginning May 8th
- Marmet Recreation Center will host special library programming and events throughout the year.
- **Riverside Public Library** is located 8 miles from Marmet at 1 Warrior Way, Suite 104, Belle, WV 25015
- **Glasgow Branch Library** is located 11 miles from Marmet in Glasgow's Municipal Building at 129 4th Avenue, Glasgow, WV 25086
- **Library Card holders** can always access KCPL online service by visiting the KCPL website at www.kcpls.org.

Will the Book Drop be available?

Yes.

What happens if I have items I have checked out from the Marmet Library?

The book drop will remain open for returning items. Please feel free to drop off your items at other locations as well. The Bookmobile will be making regular stops in Marmet and you can return your items as well.

Can I place holds during the time that the Library is closed?

You will be unable to choose Marmet as a pickup location after April 30, 2025. However, you may choose another KCPL pickup library, such as Riverside or the Bookmobile.

What if I have an item with a hold at Marmet?

Anything that remains on our hold shelves when we close will be placed on the **Bookmobile** for pickup at the first time the Bookmobile stops in Marmet. If you would like your hold sent elsewhere, please let us know or you can change the hold pickup yourself online through the *My Account* feature on our website.

What about the items I have holds on but have not received a notice to pick up?

We will change the pickup library to be **Bookmobile**. However, if you would prefer a different pickup, please let us know or you can change the hold pickup yourself online through the *My Account* feature on our website.

Can I submit an Interlibrary Loan (ILL) request while you are closed?

Please contact another KCPL location to request an ILL. You will need to arrange to pick it up and drop it off at another location.

What about overdue fines?

KCPL is mostly fine free except on specific item formats. Since the Bookmobile will be making stops in the area, no fines will be waived.
